LEGAL PROCESS

To be able to train to become a Driving Instructor you must:

- Be aged 21 years or over
- Have held a full UK Driving Licence for 3 years (you are able to start your training prior to 3 years)
- Not have more than 5 penalty points
- Have not been disqualified from driving within the last 4 years
- Have to be able to read a new style number licence plate from 27.5 metres/90 feet, contacts or glasses are accepted
- Be a Fit and Proper Person which means obtaining a DBS (enhanced Level Disclosure and Barring Service) formerly known as CRB check

QUALIFICATION TO BECOME A DRIVING INSTRUCTOR

To work legally as a qualified driving instructor in the UK you are required to pass 3 Driver Vehicle Standards Agency (DVSA) qualifying examinations...

Theory and Hazard Perception • Driving ability • Test of your ability to teach

PART 1 – THEORY & HAZARD PERCEPTION

Part 1 is a 90-minute multiple choice computer based theory test and hazard perception test.

We will supply all relevant course material for the Part 1 along with online and telephone support.

The theory part of the test comprises of 100 multiple choice questions. You are required to achieve at least 85 correct answers, you also need a minimum mark of 20 in each of the 4 areas covering:

- Road procedure
- Traffic signs and signals
- Car control
- Pedestrians
- Mechanical knowledge
- Driving test
- Disabilities
- Law

Instructional techniques

On the Hazard Perception part of the test you will be shown 14 video clips, each containing at least one developing hazard. You are required to identify the hazards scoring a minimum of 57 out of a maximum of 75 marks to pass.

Only once you have successfully passed part one are you able to apply for the Part 2 test.

PART 2 – DRIVING ABILITY

The driving test is very similar to the current learner test, but you are required to demonstrate a slightly higher level of safe and controlled driving.

At the start of the test you will be asked to read a number plate at the required distance.

During the test you will be asked 5 vehicle safety questions. These will consist of 3 'Show Me' and 2 'Tell Me' questions. You will be required to 'Show and 'Tell' the examiner according to the questions asked.

Throughout the Part 2 training you will be given 10 hours of one to one quality in-car training along with all the relevant work and study files to help you pass this test. Your dedicated trainer will guide you through the process of Part 2 and will always be on hand to advise and support you with any questions or queries you may have in between each training session.

PART 3 – TEST OF YOUR ABILITY TO TEACH

Once you have successfully passed Parts 1 and 2 you will be able to apply for Part 3 of the test. Part 3 is designed to assess your instruction and your ability to pass your knowledge onto your learner in the correct manner.

Part 3 has recently been restructured by the DVSA and our trainers have all had the relevant training to keep up to date with the latest developments.

On the test you will take a learner or full licence holder and demonstrate your planned lesson to the examiner who will be assessing your teaching methods. You will be marked on 17 areas of competence that are grouped into 3 categories:

- Lesson planning
- Risk assessment
- Teaching and learning strategies

You will be scored from 0 to 3 for each of the 17 competencies, these are totalled to give your final mark. The minimum mark you must achieve to pass is 30 out of 51 with a score of 8 or more on the risk assessment section.

You will receive 42 hours of quality training from your dedicated trainer along with all the relevant work files and training aids. Our ORDIT accredited trainers regularly enhance their knowledge of the latest changes by attending ORDIT training workshops run by the DVSA.

OUR TRAINING COURSES

Arksey offers various training packages each offering up to 52 hours of in-car training. Each course is carried out near to your home town or close to a relevant driving test centre.

Fast Track Training Course

This has become the most popular of our courses, it is designed for individuals who would like to qualify as an approved driving instructor in the shortest time possible. Your allocated trainer will guide you through all 3 parts of the test within a structured training programme. This course requires your time and dedication but with that comes the benefit of becoming a qualified instructor faster.

Standard Training Course

This course has been designed for people who would prefer to train at their own pace to qualify as an approved driving instructor. Each session will be arranged with your allocated trainer who will guide and support you through the training programme.

Premium Training Course

We will tailor a training programme specifically for your requirements to help you successfully pass all three parts of the qualifying tests. Included in this course are up to 15 hours of additional 1-1 training with an ORDIT qualified trainer which is held in reserve should you be unsuccessful at an attempt.

Pay As You Go

This is designed identical to our Standard course but with the added benefit of paying in instalments (see course fees for details).

All training packages include training material, software, reading guides, work files as well as full support from our training officers relevant to each part of the course. Free visual aids are also available to help you successfully pass the Part 3 test.

Test fees are not included in the course and are payable directly to the DVSA.

Once you have successfully passed all three tests you can apply for your ADI (Approved Driving Instructor) Badge. The cost of this badge is £300 and is payable directly to the DVSA. This allows you to teach and take money for your driving lessons.

Once you have passed your **Part 2** and completed the training for Part 3 you are allowed to carry out work as a trainee driving instructor provided you are sponsored, which Arksey will be able to help you with.
